From the Course

After turning the irrigation system back on for the season there are several leaks on the course, large ones. We are doing our best to take care of these. Grass has also started growing so our work load has increased. We do however have some more staff starting in May after universities have let out for the summer. Thank you for your patience.

Spring pre-emerge (Prodiamine) will continue to be sprayed as weather allows. For the past couple years we have sprayed 50 acres of turf in our spring pre-emerge. This season we have purchased enough chemical to spray 160 acres or *ALL* of our maintained course turf. Although the rains have put us behind on spraying, you should notice fewer weeds in rough areas than seasons past.
